

Lamb's Lunch starting strong at First Pres

Ministry serves over 100 guests each Saturday

Lamb's Lunch—a First-Pres-based outreach to the homeless of Boulder County—started up again in November, offering a hot meal, fellowship, Christian music, and a message for needy men and women each Saturday until Easter.

Over 100 guests are being served each Saturday. The Lamb's Lunch is one facet of the Lamb's Ministry, which also offers Laundry Tuesday, Lamb's Café Thursday mornings, and clothing through the Deacons' Closet.

Saturday, November 20, guests—some of whom were using canes for support, others wheelchairs or walkers—feasted on chicken, vegetables, and rice prepared by the First Pres Deacons, led by Scott McVicker. His crew started cooking at 8:00 A.M. in order to have the meal ready at noon. The deacons

John Mier and his family provided gospel music and encouraging words before the meal. Lamb's Ministry volunteers also provided jeans, socks, and long underwear,

as well as toiletries and scarves, to 42 people. Ryan Kirkpatrick, a member of First Pres, commented, "Many were quite happy we had not just long underwear pants, but also tops. When I gave one man both, he was so surprised he almost started crying."
