The 17th Annual Boulder Footwash will take place Saturday, March 31! FPC and other churches will minister to low-income families and the homeless. People are needed to prepare and serve food, paint faces, pray, set up, clean up and wash feet (we are especially in need of

those who can cut hair).

The Lamb's Lunch, a multi-church outreach to the Boulder's homeless community, continues to serve a hot meal each Saturday at First Pres. The ministry, which opens each November, culminates in a Footwash celebration on Saturday, March 31.

The Saturday meals—complete with message, music, prayer, and fellowship—will close the season on March 31 with the traditional Boulder Footwash. The Footwash supplements the regular lunch activities with a movie, clothing distribution, Easter eggs, face painting, greeting cards, a band and sing-along, medical personnel to check and minister to guests' feet, hair cutting, and—of course—the washing of feet. This last is in memory of and obedience to Jesus' Last Supper command to his disciples to be servants and wash one another's feet (John 13:12.)
